Book Report Choices

As you decide who you would like to dress up as for Character Dress Up Day on October 31st please look at the following book report choices. Lightly color in what you choose to do and bring in the completed book report on Monday, Oct. 31st to share with your teacher and classmates.

<p>Make a <u>paper bag puppet</u> to show the character you are dressing up as in your book. Add details by using construction paper, yarn, or other materials.</p>	<p>Make a <u>mobile</u> of the characters in your book. Be sure it can be hung in the classroom. Please don't make it too heavy and try not to use store bought items.</p>	<p>Use one half of a poster board or a large piece of construction paper for this project. Divide paper (poster) into four sections and label the sections: <u>Title, Beginning, Middle, and End.</u> Write 3-4 sentences for each section and illustrate.</p>
<p>Make a <u>book jacket</u> for the book from which your character is in. This should include everything that you would find on a book jacket from the library. Please do not tape the jacket to the book.</p>	<p>Make a <u>commercial</u> advertising the book from which your character is in. Please include why you liked the book and why you recommend it to others. It may be taped at home or just preformed here at school. No reading notes. It should be memorized and rehearsed at home.</p>	<p>Make a <u>Venn diagram</u> comparing yourself to the character you are dressed up as. Please include at least 4 ideas for each section (12 in all). Teachers will provide the blank Venn diagram.</p>
